

How to use a .page template in SBC+3

Once you have opened an existing project or created a new project then you can import your .page template.

You will go to Import Page under the Home button.

You will maneuver through your files to where you downloaded your .page files to. From there you can select the page file you would like to work with. Once you have your page file selected then you will click Get Page.

Then you should be able to drag and drop your photos in to the different photo spots and move them around as needed. On some of my templates you'll notice a jagged edge around the photo frame. All you need to do to straighten this out is after you drag and drop the image and get it arranged as you want is to flatten the image and it should smooth out the edges.

To fill certain elements/paper spots with paper you will “get photos” (to the right of the software under the photos tab) and this is where you can get your digital scrapbooking papers. You will click on the spot you want to “fill” with certain paper and then you will select that paper under the photos tab and you will right click or hit the down arrow and you will click “insert photo into selected frame”. If you have already installed kits through Content Manager, you can import papers and embellishments through your Content tab.

Some of the elements/embellishments on my templates are just ideas of where you can add your own digital elements and embellishments. Simply add your own elements and place over top and you can hide or delete my layers.
